Reporting to Senior Legal Counsel, the incumbent will assume the following duties as part of a high performance legal team:

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct legal research and provide advice on a wide range of matters in relation to the functions and operations of the IA
- Provide advice on the performance of the IA's statutory functions, including the administration and enforcement of the relevant Ordinances
- Work with different divisions in the IA to assist in crafting practical and legally sound solutions on a range of regulatory situations which might arise, to ensure policyholders are protected
- Provide strategic legal guidance and drafting support on correspondence on supervisory and complex complaints matters
- Assist in providing advice and comment on the drafting of key legislative initiatives relating to the insurance market
- Engage other divisions to develop or modify internal policies, practices and procedures
- Perform other duties as assigned by senior management to facilitate the administration and performance of the statutory functions of the IA

Requirements

- A law degree preferably from a common law jurisdiction (e.g. Hong Kong, Australia, England and Singapore) and admitted to practice as a solicitor or barrister in Hong Kong
- At least 5 years' post-qualification work experience gained from reputable law firms, regulatory agencies or financial institutions, preferably in the insurance industry; Applicants with less experience may be considered for an Assistant Legal Counsel position
- Knowledge of the insurance industry would be an advantage
- Excellent command of spoken and written English and Chinese
- Strong work ethic, analytical, communication and interpersonal skills
