Senior Legal Counsel

Reporting to the General Counsel, the incumbent will assume the following duties as part of a high performance legal team:

Key Responsibilities

- Provide legal advice on the performance of the IA's statutory functions and a broad range of matters affecting the IA
- Provide legal advice on supervision of insurers and insurance intermediaries as well as insurance groups under the group wide supervision regime
- Provide legal advice on the development of legislation, rules and guidelines on new regulatory frameworks, e.g. risk based capital
- Working with different divisions in the IA to assist in crafting practical and legally sound solutions on a range of regulatory situations which might arise, to ensure policyholders are protected
- Develop and advise on internal policies, practices and procedures

Requirements

- A Bachelor's degree in Law preferably from a common law jurisdiction (e.g. Hong Kong, Australia, England and Singapore) and admitted to practice as a solicitor or barrister in Hong Kong
- At least 10 years' post-qualification work experience, with a regulatory agency, law firm or in-house, preferably in the insurance industry or a financial institution
- Knowledge of regulatory frameworks and relevant laws relating to the insurance industry and other financial services sectors
- Demonstrable ability to understand complex issues and give practical, well-reasoned and researched written legal advice
- Excellent analytical, interpersonal and communication skills
- Excellent command of written and spoken English and Chinese
