Reporting to Associate Director (Group-wide Supervision), the incumbent will assume the following:

Key Responsibilities

- Head and manage a team of regulatory / professional staff
- Performing prudential supervision of major insurance groups through financial risk monitoring
- Monitor life insurance groups' compliance with group capital requirements under the group-wide supervision framework and alignment with international capital standards
- Liaise with industry, professional and international bodies on matters relating to the regulation and development of the life insurance industry
- Prepare technical review reports and participate in supervisory college discussions. Liaise with fellow insurance regulators and other financial regulators on financial risk related matters in the supervision of major insurance groups
- Perform other duties as assigned by senior management to facilitate the administration of the statutory functions of IA

Requirements

- A Bachelor's degree in actuarial science or related disciplines
- Fellow actuary with minimum 8 years' relevant work experience (5 years of which were attained after becoming fellow) in risk and capital management, life actuarial practice, or regulatory fields
- Sound knowledge of regulatory requirements and supervisory standards, asset/ liability and capital management, industry practices relating to the insurance business, and the ability to proactively identify risks and exercise good judgement in determining effective strategies for the supervision of major insurance groups
- Strong analytical, leadership, interpersonal and communication skills
- Can-do attitude, self-starter and open to challenging tasks
- Excellent command of written and spoken English
